Clarke brings much experience to the board as former president and CEO of Lone Star Industries (1999-2004), one of the largest Portland cement producers in the United States. Prior to Lone Star, he was President and CEO of Glens Falls of Cement Company (1973-1999). Mr. Clarke served as Chairman of the Board of the Portland Cement Association, which is the trade association for the cement industry in the U.S and Canada. Mr. Clarke is retired and works as a consultant for the construction materials industry.

Mr. Clarke is a director of Arrow Financial Corp., a \$1.5 billion bank holding company in upstate New York. He is also a member of the Board of Governors of the Glens Falls Hospital, a \$250 million community hospital. Mr. Clarke has also served as Chairman of the Hyde Collection Art Museum

As an experienced CEO with a successful track record in team building and leadership as well as an excellent balance among sales, operations and financial skills, Clarke is a huge asset to our board. Clarke brings superior inter-personal skills, is adept at motivating and challenging people and building high quality management teams. Skilled at identifying and developing strategic direction, we trust Clarke to help guide Access Anything in a forward and successful direction.

Access Anything is also very proud to welcome Christopher Jehn, Vice President Government Programs of Cray Inc to the Access Anything Board of Directors. Before joining Cray Inc in 2001, Mr. Jehn served President George H. W. Bush as the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Force Management and Personnel. Jehn also served as the Executive Director of the National Defense Panel and, in 1997 through 1998, as a member of the Commission on Service members and Veterans Transition Assistance. He joined the Congressional Budget Office in 1998 as its Assistant Director for National Security, responsible for directing CBO's National Security Division. For the U. S. Congress, the National Security Division conducts economic and budget analyses of the policies and programs of the Departments of Defense, State, and Veterans' Affairs.

Most applicable for Access Anything is Jehn's tenure on the U.S. Access Board (formerly known as the Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board) from 1989 to 1993 where he helped write the accessibility guidelines to implement to the Americans with Disabilities Act.

An economist, Mr. Jehn was educated at Beloit College and the University of Chicago. Before he joined the Bush Administration in 1989, he was Vice President and Director of the Marine Corps Operations

Analysis Group at CNA, responsible for all CNA's work—weapon systems assessments, human resources analyses, program and budget evaluations, and operational and tactical analyses—for the U.S. Marine Corps.

Mr. Jehn, a National Merit Scholar, was a University Fellow at the University of Chicago. Among his other awards and honors are the Benjamin Hooks Distinguished Service Award from the NAACP, the Distinguished Public Service Medal from the Department of Defense, and the Meritorious Police Cross from the government of Spain. He was appointed to the Commission on Service members and Veterans Transition Assistance by the Senate Armed Services Committee.

Jehn currently represents Cray Inc in Washington and helps Cray leadership and Cray's sales and marketing staff communicate with, and better understand, Cray's public sector customers. Jehn hopes to represent Access Anything in Washington as well by supporting Access Anything's goals of improving the lives of disabled veterans.

In addition, Access Anything also proudly welcomes Mario Fausto, California Attorney at Law to its Board of Directors. Mr. Fausto is currently acting General Corporate Counsel for S.A.S.A.N., Inc., Construction Club, Inc. and Raissi Real Estate Development, LLC and is also a founding partner at the law firm of Sayar Czarkowski Fausto, LLP, focusing on corporate and securities law.
