Stay tuned for our *book tour calendar* in the next newsletter! We will have stops at rehabilitation centers, our home towns, and travel and adventure expos.

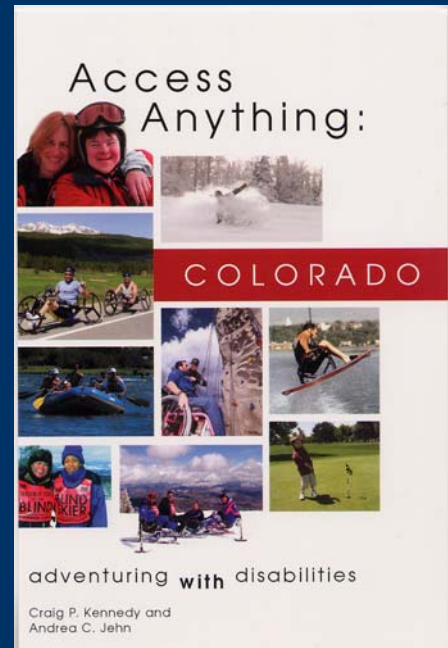
We are also confirmed to be at Fulcrum's booth at the [Outdoor Retailers Show](#) in Utah again, August 11-14 for a book signing.

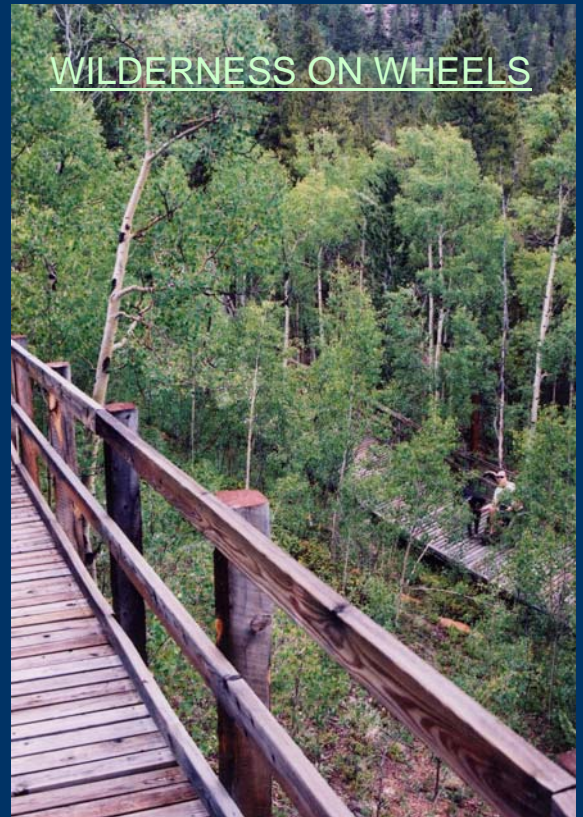
