The book is now at the printer for all of June and set to hit the shelves July 15th!

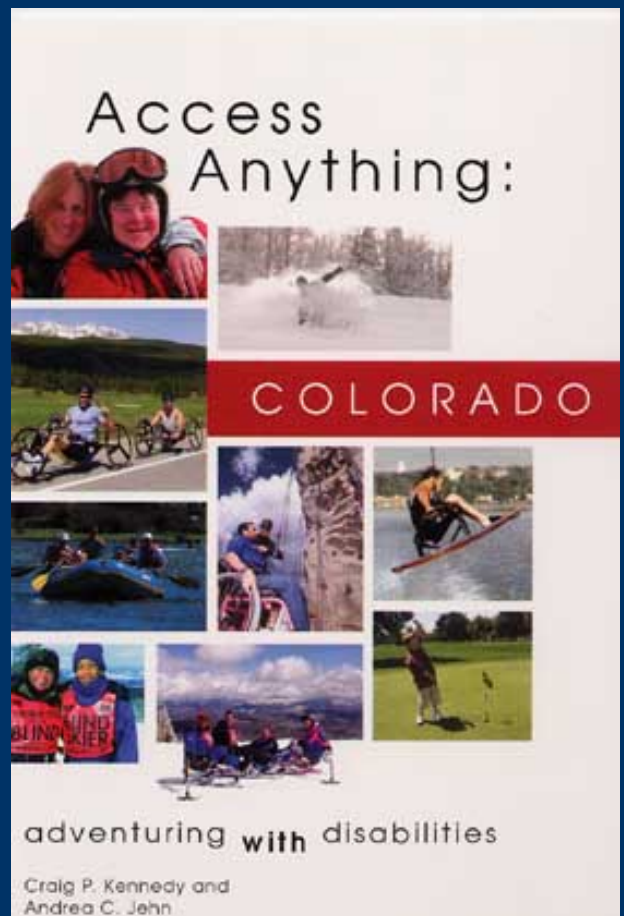

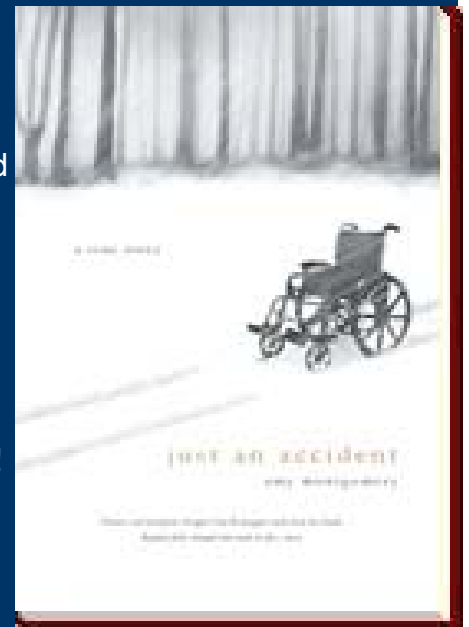

Just an Accident

The story of Scott Remington's accident is almost burlier than the man himself. Author Amy Montgomery tells the detailed events surrounding the logging accident that left Scott paralyzed on May 25, 1999 as well as the emotional rollercoaster of the next 6 years. Each year Scott and his family dedicate themselves to an annual fundraiser for the Christopher Reeve Foundation (near Craig's own hometown!) in Brant Lake, New York. We've both read this book with tears in our eyes and warmth in our hearts! Craig has sent a donation to the fundraiser since its inception in 2000. Each year the fundraiser beats the prior year's take-in, and this year they raised \$38,000!! A portion of the book's sales are donated to the [Christopher Reeve Paralysis Foundation](#).

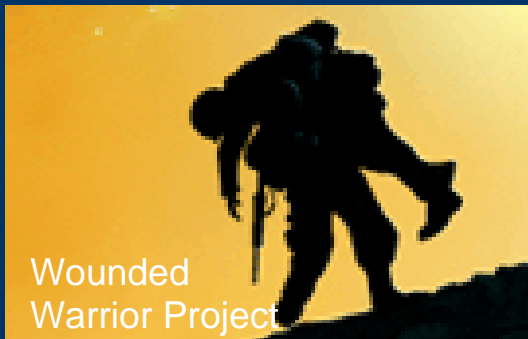
